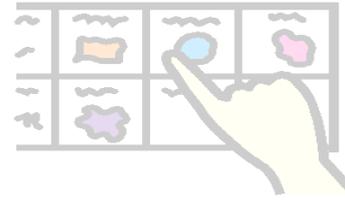




Communication and Interaction Ideas
