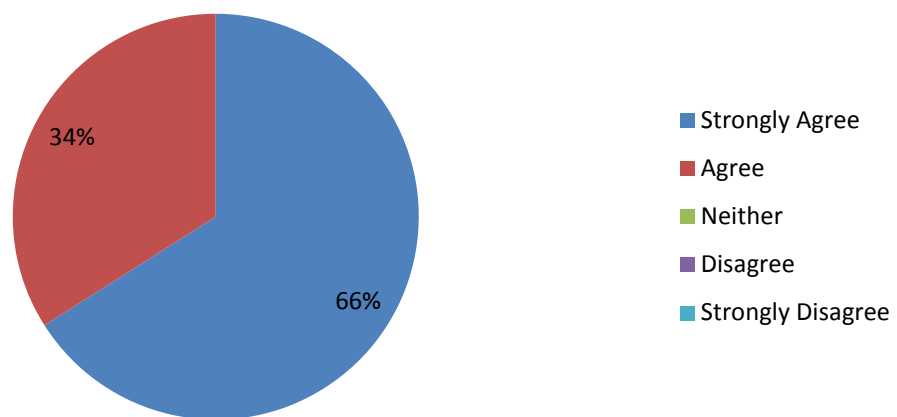
### Q2 - My child is happy in school



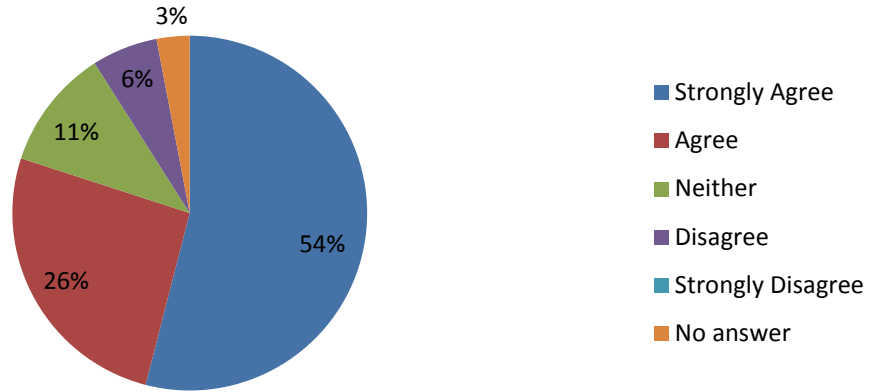
**Q3 My child or young person is well cared for by the staff at Kelford School**



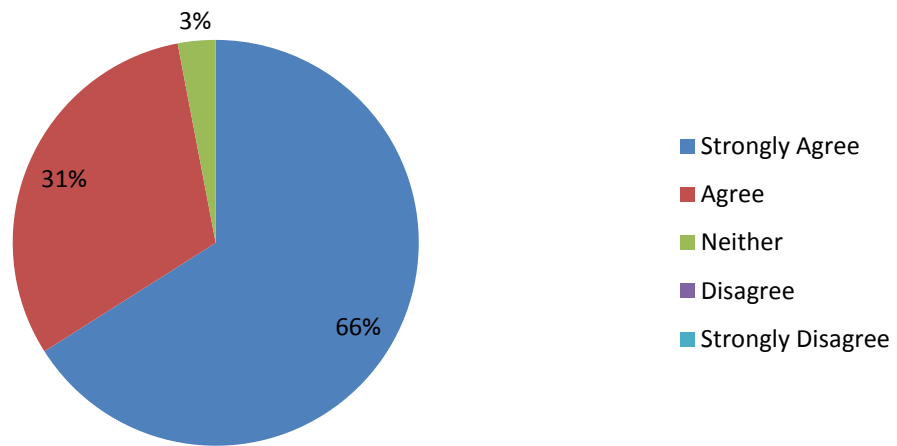
**Q4 - The school encourages pupils to display good behaviour.**



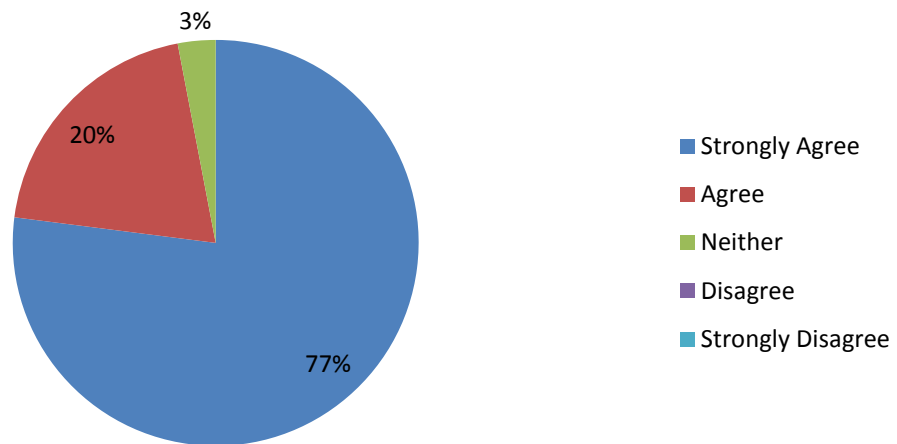
**Q5 - Kelford School has informed me about the procedures to deal with child protection matters.**



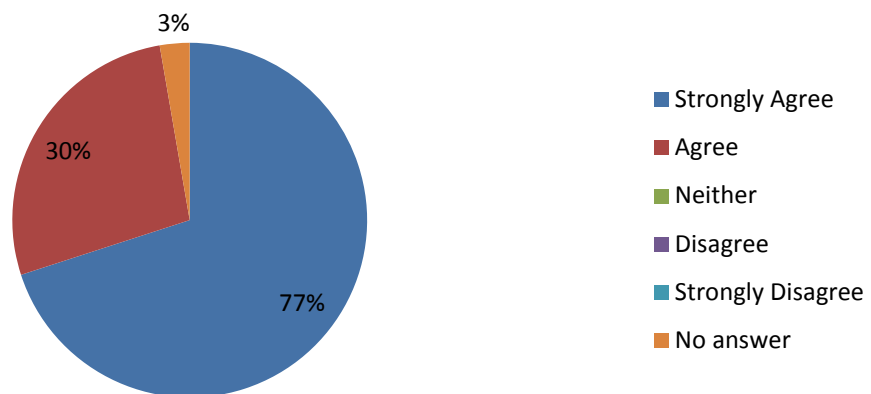
**Q6 - Kelford School has explained to me how I can help my child with his / her work.**



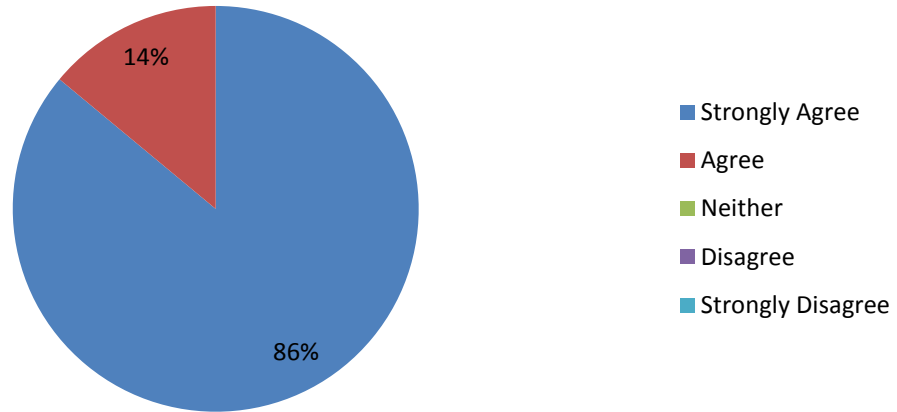
**Q7 - I am informed regularly about the life and work of the school.**



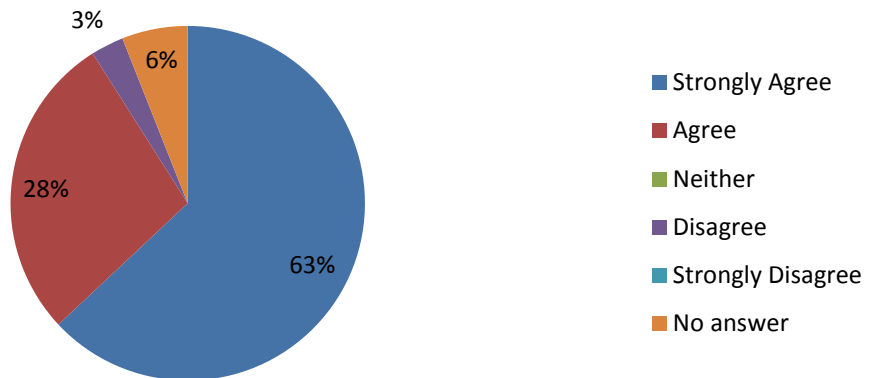
**Q8 - Kelford School provides opportunities for my child to participate in out of school activities ie visits.**
