

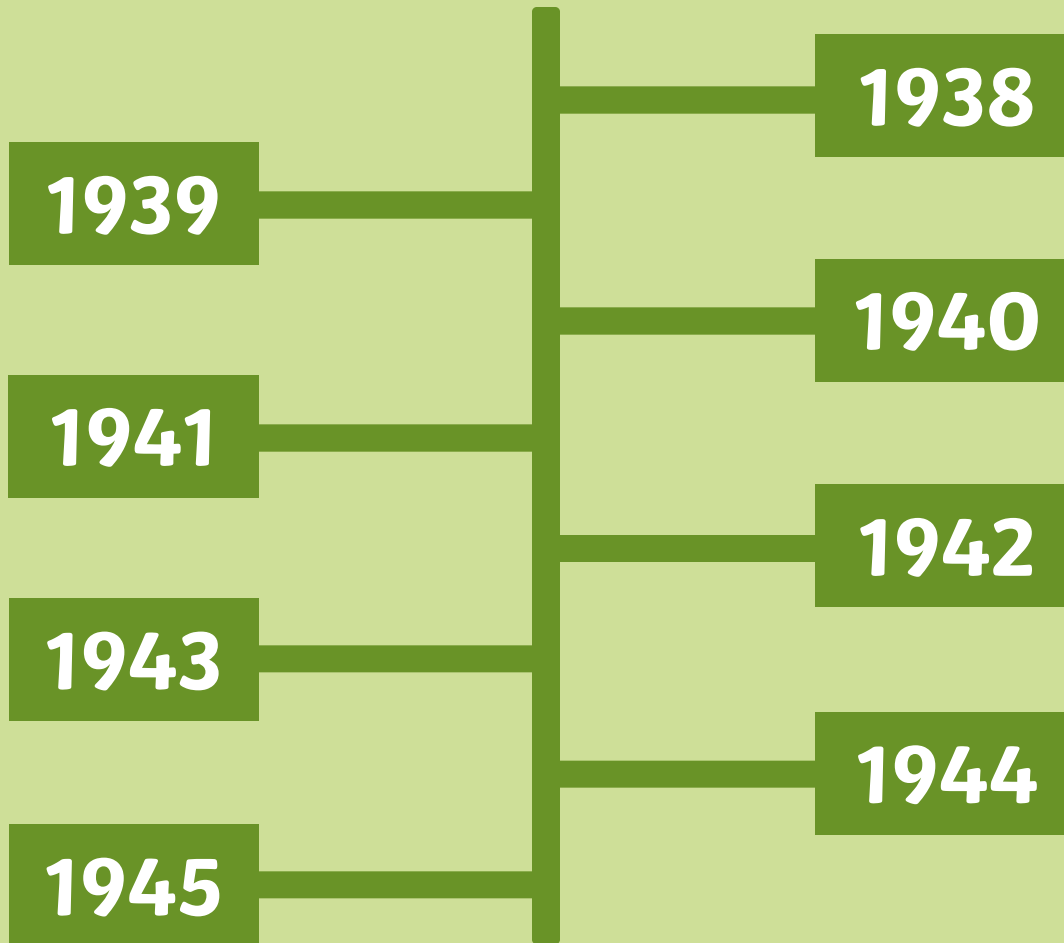
Behind The Bombs

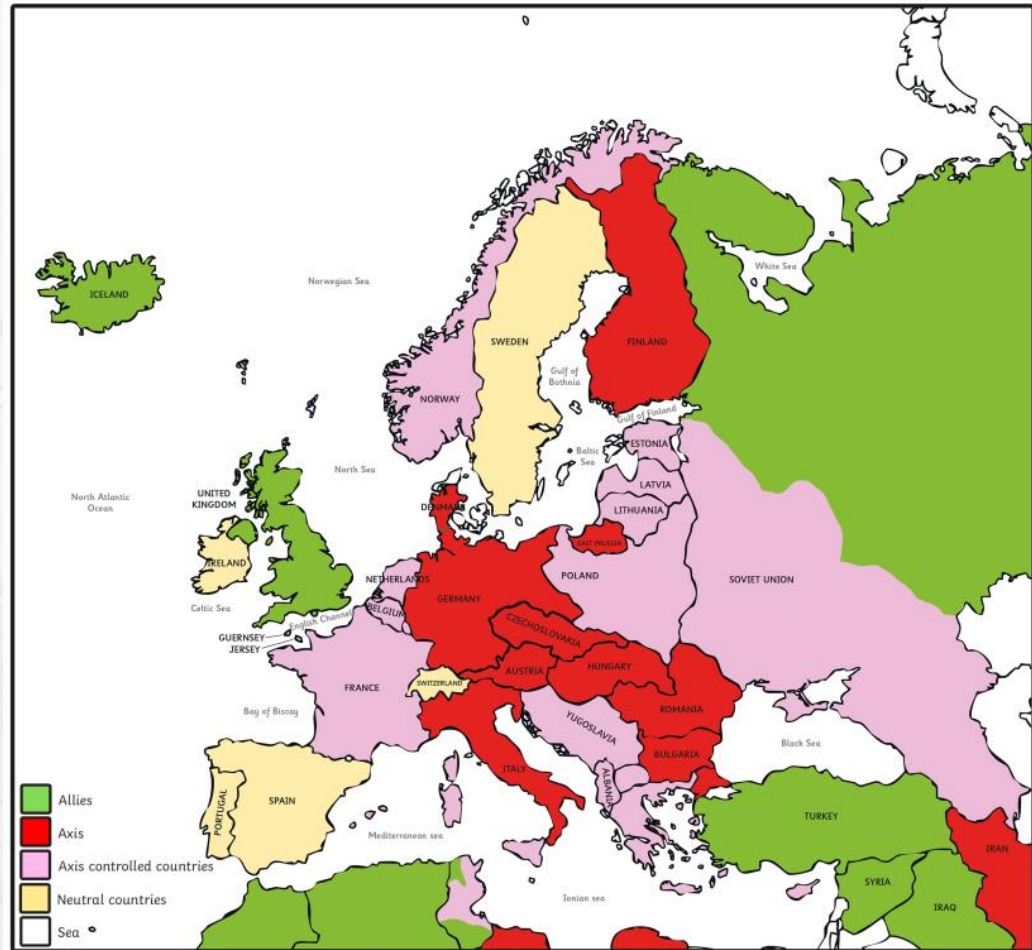
Where is Germany?

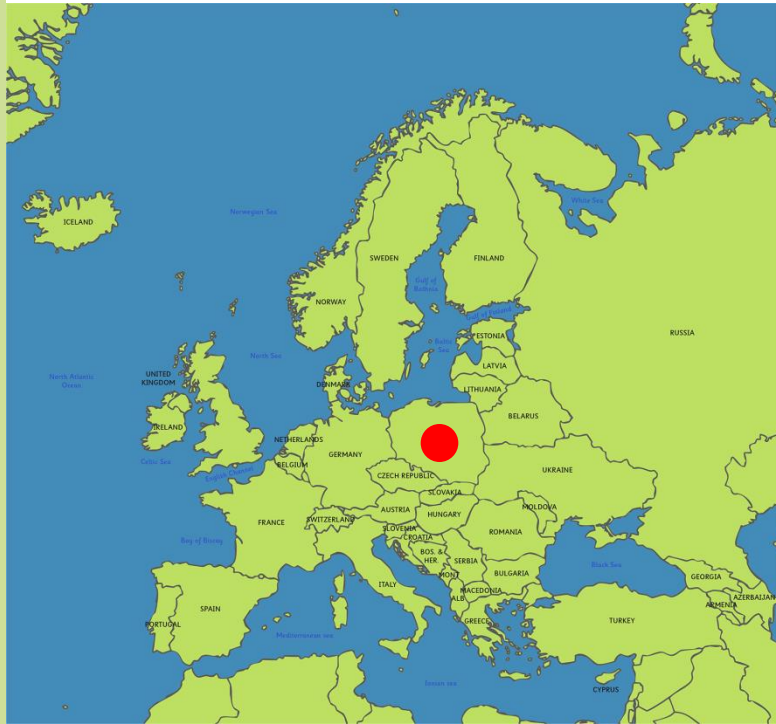
The war began when Germany thought they could take over other countries and make them part of Germany.

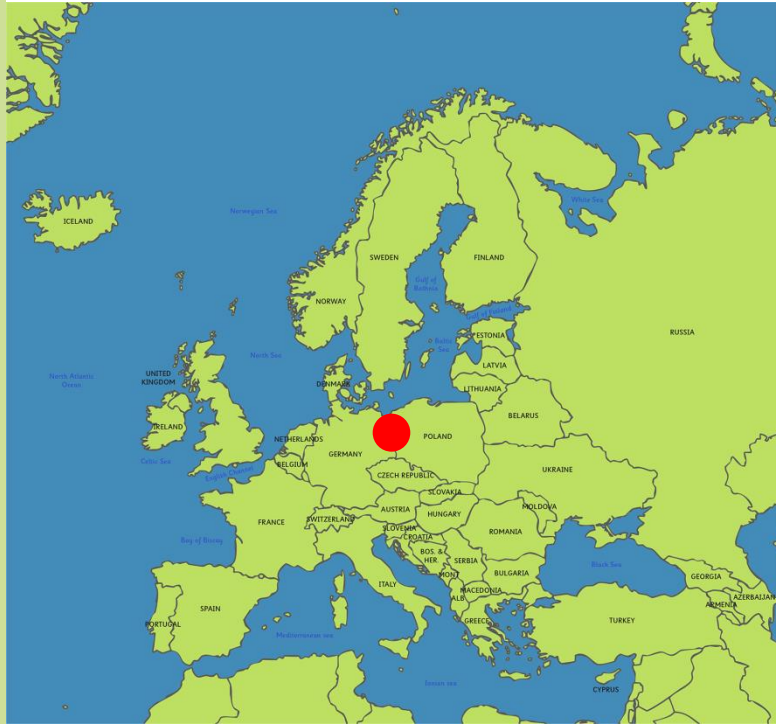


Germany and the Soviet Union were on the same team. They wanted to invade Poland and be in charge of everyone there
