

## **Year 7 Catch-Up Funding 2015/16**

### **Background:**

The Year 7 Catch-up funding is monies received by the school from the Government. The money received by the school is to target Year 7 pupils that did achieve at least level 4 in reading and /or maths at the end of Key Stage 2. Schools receive an additional £500 for each pupil in Year 7 who fulfils this criteria.

The Headteacher on behalf of the Governing Body can decide how the funding is to be spent and is accountable for ensuring it has maximum impact.

### **Amount:**

For the academic year 2015/16, the allocation for Kelford School was £2000 based on 4 pupils.

### **Impact:**

The money received was used to provide 1:1 learning time to facilitate personalised learning within Maths and English.

100% of pupils made at least expected or better than expected progress in all aspects of English: Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing.

100% of pupils made at least expected or better than expected progress in all aspects of Maths: Number, Using and Applying and Shape, Space and Measure.
