Now we have finished the career planning unit, this term we will be looking at CVs and the skills and attributes that you need for certain jobs in more depth and all students will have the opportunity to complete one and will be able to identify the skills and attribute that they already have or may need to develop to meet the criteria for the jobs they are interested in

English

This term in English we will continue to work towards the Functional Skills English criteria at the appropriate level for the student. In the level 1 class we are looking more in depth at the writing element while thinking about complaints and producing a letter of complaint. Exams for those students who are ready are on the horizon so practice questions and intervention sessions will be included on the timetable.

Duke of Edinburgh

Some of our young people will choose to take part in the Duke of Edinburgh award. This term the voluntary work continues with our students carrying on with the project working with Thornbury Animal Sanctuary. Students will attend this on a rotational basis with all those who want to take part in various voluntary roles at the animal sanctuary.

Leisure

This term our leisure options are bowling at the Superbowl or games at The View. We may also explore some fitness options. Our young people will be able to access both options if they want. The bowling trip is also a good way to access the community, use money to buy refreshments and spend social time with their peers.

Maths

This term we will continue working towards the functional skills criteria at the appropriate level for the student. In the E3 class we are looking at measure shape and space and also for those who are ready exams are on the horizon so practice papers, questions and intervention sessions will be added to the timetable

PSHE

This term we will continue to look at making safe and healthy choices around subjects such as consent and contraceptives. Identifying risky behaviours and thinking about what we can do to protect ourselves from these risks.

Youth Sports Award

Some of our young people will choose to take part in the Youth Sports Award at Abbey School. This involves taking part in a variety of sporting activities and also learning how to lead a session.

The accreditation we work towards is the Prince's Trust personal development and employability. Our young people work towards an award, certificate or a diploma and we deliver units such as:
