## **PRIMARY**

We have had another busy week in Primary. Our Animal Kingdoms topic has continued into this week with some pupils choosing different materials to make animal masks. They were very pleased with their efforts and used them to get into character during role play! Some pupils have also used touchscreen technology to draw animals and select the correct colours and patterns to make them come to life.

In Maths, pupils have continued to learn about how to measure. They have compared different items around the classroom and compared their lengths using either standard measurements (centimetres and metres), or non-standard units such as bricks, blocks or beads. This has been extended in some classes, where pupils have then estimated the length before checking. It has been wonderful to see progress across the classes.

# **SECONDARY**

We have had a fabulous week up in Secondary with lots of work around patterns and number, phonics and reading. We have done some amazing exploring at looking habitats and also had a trip out to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park.

Over in Sixth form students have been busy working on their independence skills by cooking their own dinner. They have enjoyed a Chinese inspired lunch and have also been crafting away making things to celebrate the Chinese New Year of the Dragon.
